Pastor Update- Sarah McManus (consultant for Eastside Catholics Long Range Plan) will be introduced in the future as she was ill today.

Principal Update-

- Incentive for Raffle tickets
 - Looking for new ideas for motivation. Idea raised that students could earn a day off of school (possibly a Friday before Memorial Day) if enough funds raised. This would NOT be for this school year. More discussion needed.
- Algebra Morning Class or alternative
 - This would be for 8th grade students given opportunity to advance to Algebra I their 8th grade year
 - 8th grade teacher & students need more time to fill in gaps from Pre- Algebra that these student miss by advancing.
 - Idea has been presented to Finance and map of process made by teachers.
 - Administration has been in touch with AOC regarding this as well as area high schools re: their testing information to better serve our students.
 - Before school class deemed difficult for families with multiple SMS drop off times- ideas suggest to have a short summer session in August for these students to get the needed pre-algebra teachings. Parents will be informed in writing of process and will have option to remain in pre-algebra.

Parent Matters-

- Active parishioner (AP) summary updated
 - Most families apply for AP tuition scholarship
 - Tuition is one rate for all students with scholarship opportunities vs 2 rates for in/out of parishioner
 - Families will be notified if they don't qualify- this is a small number.
 - Per Fr. Jamie- the most important way to qualify is to attend Mass regularly and envelopes are the best way to track this.
